

SuzAnne Frederickson Abshire

SuzAnne M. Abshire, 75, of Kingston, Washington, died of natural causes on April 7, 2014.

Born in Anchorage, Alaska, Dec. 1, 1938, Ms. Abshire grew up in Seattle and Edmonds, Washington. She was a master gardener and an accomplished florist and artist.

SuzAnne was also an expert in antiques and owned and managed an antiques business in Port Townsend, Washington during the 1970s. In the late 1980s and early 1990s, she designed, remodeled and rebuilt her home on Diamond Point, near Sequim, Washington, with magnificent views of the Strait of Juan de Fuca and Protection Island.

She is survived by her sister, Joan Douglas of Los Angeles, California; brother, Roy Fredericksen of Edmonds; daughter Gillian Gregory of Kingston; son, Marc Abshire, of Washington, D.C.; daughter Diane Salguero of Port Townsend; and eight grandchildren.

A private memorial event to celebrate Ms. Abshire's loving and artistic life is to be held for family and friends in June.
